Watch The Sunset On Cable Beach!

From here you can watch the camels leave the beach after sunset rides and see the sun slip out of sight over the stunning ocean horizon beyond the palm trees! Book A Car or Scooter

Taxis are very expensive in Broome and Broome is very spread out – not matter where you are. We highly recommend you hire a car and do this as early as you can as they get booked out. The Broome Bird Observatory

Located just 25km from Broome on an unsealed road. You can self drive or a transfer service may be available at a cost. Roebuck Bay has the greatest diversity of shorebird species of any site on the planet and around 150,000 of these birds visit annually. The magnificent coastal scenery of the bay provides a fitting backdrop for the birds and is a stunning attraction in its own right. As a day visitor you can walk the self guided botanical trails, enjoy the beach, observe the shorebirds and relax in the shade house which overlooks the bird baths, or book one of their tours; Shorebirds Tour or Mangrove Tour \$70pp – 2.5hrs incl morning tea; Bush & Plains Afternoon Tour - \$70pp; Lakes Full Day Tour - \$150pp incl morning tea, BYO lunch.



Kayak Off Cable Beach

Experience the natural wonders of Broome's coastline on a paddle adventure. Take time to explore this amazing marine environment where you have a chance to spot a sea turtle from your kayak. Staircase To The Moon

Staircase to the Moon is a natural phenomenon which occurs when a full moon rises over the exposed tidal flats of Roebuck Bay. The Staircase to the Moon happens 2 - 3 days a month between March and October. The first two days of Staircase to the Moon generally also play host to the Staircase to the Moon markets at Town Beach. Here you can sample local produce, buy hand made products, a variety of international food, and enjoy the sounds of local entertainers. Another popular spot to view the event is The Mangrove Hotel Resort, with live entertainment every Staircase night.



A Taste of Broome

A must see when coming to Broome! An indigenous art & cultural event that showcases the history of Broome to a mix of music, media, dance, food, arts & crafts. Lots of local creative talent and the best chicken satays!! The show is on once a month, worth planning your trip around if you are heading to the North West! Tickets need to be booked in advance.

Whale Watching

Sunset Dolphin Cruise

Wander the Markets!

The Broome Courthouse Markets are held in the beautiful Heritage listed gardens of the Broome Courthouse. Started over 25 years ago by a small group of locals wishing to trade local product, they have grown to become a major tourist attraction in Broome and host up to 115 creative stalls over the Dry Season.

Walk like a Dinosaur

For nature of a more historical kind, nothing gets much more ancient than the 130 million year old **Dinosaur** Footprints which can be seen at very low tides at **Gantheaume Point**.

Footprints can be viewed at Gantheaume Point at tides below 2.16m. As the rocks can be slippery and steep, we recommend a high level of mobility and sturdy shoes are required.



Moontide Gin Distillery

Visit Broome's only Gin Distillery and do an informal tour and sample their wares. Tastings at our cellar door - Wednesday to Sunday - 12 midday till 6 pm. Sample spirits, both neat and paired with a mixer. Tastings are \$14 - you'll receive three spirits with a mixer (each drink will contain no more than 10 mls of spirit). 1 Day Windjana Gorge, Tunnel Creek & Derby Prison Tree Tour

Travel east from Broome for a day, heading into Kimberley cattle country via the Derby Prison Tree and the Gibb River Road. Spend the morning in the outback oasis of Windjana Gorge searching for freshwater crocodiles, local birdlife and indigenous bushtucker, followed by an afternoon exploring the fascinating Tunnel Creek cave system. A swim in the waterhole is a highlight of the day. This day trip from Broome offers a delightful glimpse of Australia's beautiful Kimberley region.

Indigenous Mangrove & Mudcrab Tour

Broome's mangroves provide a sheltered habitat for a wide variety of native and aquatic animals. Teeming with life, they are both feeding grounds and nurseries for fish, molluscs, burrowing mud worms, various crustaceans, dugong and the occasional saltwater crocodile.

On the Bagul Bagul tour you will learn about the different types of mangrove trees. Experience the mangrove forest and hear about the traditional uses of mangrove wood. At low tide the mangroves are alive with mudskippers, mudcrabs and a variety of birds. Possibly sample some of the bushtucker traditionally sourced from the mangrove forest, spot the different types of crab holes, and if you are lucky, you will taste a beautiful oyster fresh off the rock. The tour takes you into the bay through pools to Buccaneer rock where you will hear the Dreaming story of Randigunya the giant. Scour the mangroves for tasty morsels and see remnants of (Asian) fish traps and hear stories from a bygone era of Broome's pearling days. Adults \$75, Children \$35 | 2 Hours
